Diagnoses

People with any advanced illness, regardless of age, may be eligible for hospice. Some common diagnoses include:

* ALS *Alzheimer's * Cancer * Congestive Heart Failure * Multiple Sclerosis * Pulmonary Disease (COPD) * End-Stage Dementia * End-Stage Liver Disease * End-Stage Renal Disease * Parkinson's Disease * Stroke

People who are coping with serious multi-symptom deterioration, frequent emergency room visits, and/or hospitalizations, or who are discontinuing aggressive treatment may also be eligible for hospice care.
